IF YOUR SUBMISSION IS SUCCESSFUL

The final teams will receive support to prepare for the public pitching competition during the AIDC. This will include a professional development session for their supporting teachers / youth workers and two training sessions for the finalists in January / February 2007.

Document Your World will be held on the first day of the conference, Friday 23 February 2007.

Each pitch will be limited to seven [7] minutes followed by feedback from the panel.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The promoter of Document Your World initiative is tallstoreez productionz Pty Ltd (TP) and the Australian International Documentary Conference (AIDC) of 12 King William Street, Unley, South Australia 5061.
2. Entry is competitive and all applications must be lodged on [or postmarked no later than] 5pm on Monday 18 December 2006.
3. You may apply as an individual, or as a school or youth group.
4. You must be an Australian resident between the ages of 12 – 17 years old at the time of lodging your application.
5. You may be from any state in Australia to apply. If you are a successful applicant you will need to organize your own accommodation, expenses and travel to Adelaide for the training and Pitch.
6. You agree to abide by the Document Your World Guidelines and these Terms and Conditions.
7. All applications will be assessed by a jury of professional filmmakers and festival organizers, nominated by AIDC. The successful applicants will be chosen at the absolute discretion of the selection panel.
8. AIDC and TP are not responsible for any damaged, late, misdirected, incomplete, illegible, stolen, lost or coincidentally similar entries.
9. All submissions must be accompanied by an entry form, with the signature of the entrant and counter signed by an adult supporter/ parent or guardian. AIDC and TP reserve the right to reject any incomplete, illegible or anti-social entries.
10. You warrant that your application is your original work and it does not infringe the intellectual property or rights of any person or entity.
11. Successful applicants will receive professional support from TP to pitch their idea. Document Your World training will take place in Adelaide, South Australia.
12. In entering this initiative, you agree that AIDC and TP, and any related parties will not be liable for any claim or damages that may occur directly or indirectly, in connection with this project [except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law].
13. By virtue of acceptance of the jury's decision, each successful applicant agrees:
 - a) to enter into an exclusive agreement with TP to develop a documentary concept during the Document Your World initiative and agrees to assign all rights in the content to TP.
 - b) to work with tallstoreez productionz, AIDC management and other professional filmmakers nominated by TP and AIDC to develop and pitch their documentary idea at AIDC 2007.
14. Document Your World pitch will take place at the Australian International Documentary Conference in Adelaide, South Australia in February 2007.
15. This initiative and promotion shall be governed by the law of South Australia.
